3. Printed and signed Application Forms must be delivered to the Proper Officer no later than 5.00 pm on 30 September 2020. The co-option of a new councillor will be considered at the Council meeting on 10 October 2020. Please note that proof of posting is not accepted as proof of receipt. Correct postage is required.

To qualify for election as a Parish Councillor, and to hold such an office, an applicant must be a British, Irish or qualifying Commonwealth citizen, or a citizen of any other member State of the European Union, and on the day of election have reached 18 years of age or over AND

- (a) on the relevant day and thereafter continues to be on the electoral register for the parish, or
- (b) during the whole 12 months preceding that day have owned or tenanted land or other premises in the parish, or
- (c) during the 12 months preceding that day their principal or only place of work has been in the parish, or
- (d) during the whole 12 months preceding that day has resided in the parish or within 3 miles of it

Disqualification from being elected a councillor is set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972, section 78A of the Local Government Act 2000 or section 34 of the Localism Act 2011.
