1. Trustees are expected to step down in rotation every three years, and any trustee doing so should give three months' notice of intention. There is no limit to the number of years a trustee may serve, provided that he or she has the support of fellow trustees. Persons wishing to become trustees should envisage a period of service of at least one year, with a period of three years being the norm.
2. Nominations will be sought from the committee and village, with the vacancy advertised through the Lodestar Magazine and through all partner organisations.
3. Any person wishing to become a trustee should write to the Chair of Trustees with a short resume and summary of ways in which he or she wishes to contribute to the charity.
4. The applicant should obtain the signed support of at least one other villager not related to the applicant.
5. A decision on the successful applicant will be made by the existing trustees supported by the Charity Committee. In the event of disagreement, the decision is with the existing trustees only.
