

Fund Raiser Volunteer

Introduction

The Charity (Lode with Longmeadow Village Trust) seeks the support of a local volunteer to manage fund raising activities on behalf of the trustees of Lode with Longmeadow Village Trust. The volunteer will be a member of the Charity Committee which organises fund raising social activities within the village.

The Charity raises money for the benefit of parishioners according to its constitution. Part of this fund raising action is by means of profitable village activities which depend upon funding guarantees through sponsors. Money is also raised for specific charity projects via grants and donations.

Duties

- To recommend to the committee those social activities which will raise funds and provide opportunities for community well-being (e.g. events and entertainment)
- To promote and organise such activities and to find sponsors who will guarantee the cost of the activity (charity funds are not available for this)
- To assist with all aspects of fund raising
