Amendments to Standing Orders

Amendments are proposed to the supplementary Standing Orders implemented to accommodate the Coronavirus Regulations 2020 to reflect best practice advice. The clauses requiring members of the public wishing to attend the meeting to contact the Clerk would be deleted and replaced by:
