At the time of writing, I am awaiting insurance renewals for the Parish Council and Fassage Hall and Grounds. As the renewal is due before the June meeting, agreement is sought to accept increases of up to 8%. (Last year's premiums were £618.24 & £377.14 respectively) The other issue is the estimated replacement value of the moveable items on our asset register (see below). The cover we currently hold provides all risks cover on these items up to £100,000. I have sought an up to date figure for the Tennis Court from the Tennis Club but would ask for comments about any other items which may need revaluing.
